## ARTICLES

### ARTICLE II. [Special Warrant Article: Energy efficiency feasibility study.]

Shall the District raise and appropriate the sum of Ninety-Three Thousand Dollars (\$93,000) to conduct an Energy Efficiency Feasibility Study, which would include an analysis of the energy usage and potential for increased efficiency at all six schools as well as potential investments and the projected time for such investments to be paid back through energy cost savings? **(The school board recommends a "yes" vote upon this question.) (Majority ballot vote required.)**

### ARTICLE III. [Operating budget.]

Shall the school district raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including other appropriations voted separately in Article II, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Seventy-Four Million, Eleven Thousand, Three Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$74,011,321)?

(Majority ballot vote required.)**

### ARTICLE IV. [Acceptance of gifts.]

Shall the school board be authorized to accept on behalf of the district, without further action by the voters, gifts, legacies and devises of real or personal property which may become available to the district during the fiscal year? **(The school board recommends a "yes" vote upon this question.) (Majority ballot vote required.)**
