- 1) PFC water contamination We continue to monitor and work on the PFC water contamination issue and a full staff report has been provided. As noted in the full report an additional home on Juniper Drive has received a test result in excess of 70 ppt and is now being provided with bottled water.

- 3) Union Negotiations Agreement has been reached with the Fire Union negotiating committee and a ratification meeting is scheduled for January 23rd in hopes of being able to
