

## **News & Noteworthy:**

## **Project Updates:**

1) 2018 CIP & Budget – The Manager and Finance team have been working on revenue projections, fund balance standing, and tax impacts of the proposed budget. The budget will

be presented to the Council on October 24<sup>th</sup>.

2) 2018 Roads Program – The Cider Mill Road Bridge project is proceeding very well and has an anticipated November 8<sup>th</sup> opening. Limited paving along Liberty Hill Road is being completed in the worst sections to allow us to effectively plow the road this winter. Full reconstruction will take place in 2019. The Pulpit Road and the Bedford Three Corners area has been milled and will be paved in the next two weeks. The majority of the Sebbins Pond and Sandy Pond Parkway areas where gas mains have been installed will recieve base pavement in the next two weeks. Hopefully the team will have time in the season to complete work on Barrington Drive. Please continue to watch the Roads Program website for timely updates at www.bedfordroads.com
