## Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update

We continue to monitor the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic closely and have taken some initial steps to protect our employees while still providing all services. All buildings currently remain open but that is being reviewed and is likely to change even later today.

All required regulatory (Planning Board, ZBA, etc.) and Town Council meetings are being held but we are working with applicants to delay their projects if they can. All programs and meetings at the Library have been cancelled but the Library remains open. The presentation on the draft 2020 Master Plan previously scheduled for March 26<sup>th</sup> has been postponed to a future date to be determined.

We are hopeful that the State will extend required March vehicle registrations but as of now they are still required. Please consider completing your registration online through the town website.

We do ask that you not come into any public building if you are sick or have been exposed to the Coronavirus in any way. We certainly appreciate your patience while we work through this situation.
